Training Tips

Training your puppy should be a fun and rewarding experience. Naturally, there will be some challenging times as you both learn how to communicate with each other. Develop a love of learning by being consistent and training with love and patience.



Puppies learn by association, repetition and reward. Positive reinforcement is known to be the best method for training behaviours while maintaining a strong life-long relationship with your dog.

Puppy Training Tips

- Keep training sessions short and fun.
- Try out different rewards such as treats, dry food, toys, games or love and attention.
- Use reward lures and praise.
- Never force or physically push your puppy into a desired position, such as a 'sit'.
- Puppies can become distracted easily.
- Learn new behaviours in a calm and comfortable area.
- Have realistic expectations of your puppy.
- If you become frustrated or your puppy is not interested in training, play a game and try again later.
- Teach your puppy both a verbal cue and hand signal for each behaviour.
- Always end on a positive note.
