



Safe Spaces & Crate Training

Your puppy is still very young and is learning about the world around them. Creating a safe space that they can retreat to and call their own will help your puppy feel secure and build their confidence. A crate is an excellent tool for creating a safe space and can be used for independent sleep and play, safety and travel, and even toilet training.



Creating a safe space

- ✔ Have your puppy's space set up when they come home for the first time.
- ✔ Your puppy's safe space is
 - For your puppy only and;
 - Never to be used for punishment or 'time out'.

- ✔ Consider the use of pheromones.
- ✔ If using a crate, always have the crate open and available for your puppy when confinement is not needed.
